## **TG co-sponsors chat event on standardized tests, college admissions, financial aid**

ROUND ROCK, TEXAS – Students and parents who have questions about standardized tests, college admissions, and financial aid can get the answers they need during a chat event on *Mapping Your Future* (<http://mapping-your-future.org>), a public-service Web site co-sponsored by TG and other student loan guarantors. Scheduled for August 9, from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m. (CDT), the Internet chat provides a unique opportunity to receive information and guidance about standardized tests and college admissions, as well as financial aid information and instructions for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). - financial aid and the FAFSA.
