***School Fact Sheets* provide information about Texas colleges, lenders**

ROUND ROCK, TEXAS – The latest edition of TG’s *School Fact Sheets* is now available. The publication includes pertinent information about Texas educational institutions, including two- and four-year public and private institutions and proprietary schools, providing key data about the schools, the lenders they work with, and the students they serve — including demographics, typical federal student loan debt loads, and cohort default rates.

The *School Fact Sheets* are available in both an interactive html version and a printer-ready PDF format. The html version provides a list of every TG lender providing Federal Family Education Loan Program student loans at a given school with helpful links to the lender's *Lender Fact Sheet*. These lender lists within the *School Fact Sheets* report fiscal year to date loan volume at a particular school and are updated monthly.
