## **TG offers free telephone conference on interim final rules**

The U.S. Department of Education released a regulations package on August 9, 2006, for the federal student aid programs, including the Federal Family Education Loan Program (FFELP). Most of the regulations are derived from the statutory changes due to the Higher Education Reconciliation Act of 2005. To help financial aid professionals understand how these rules coordinate with the legislation on which they are based, TG is providing a free telephone conference titled “A look at the new interim final rules.”
